General: Lessons by arrangement include the wood, tools, lathes, supplies and eye shields. Students should wear a shirt or smock that will close to the neck and will easily shed woodchips. We take regular breaks for demonstration and instruction. All-day classes include time for lunch (bring your own food and drink). Available: refrigerator, micro-wave, fresh water, and hotplate.

Costs: Individual lessons for a day (8:30 to 4:30) \$175/day

(1/2 day of selected intermediate/advanced class ends at 12:30 \$90/half-day)
